

School Age (Grades 3-5) Coordinator Job Description Hourly Non-Exempt 10-12 Hours Per Week

Qualifications:

- 1. A testimony of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and evidence of a desire to live a consistent Christian life
- 2. Demonstrated lifestyle of service to the body of Christ
- 3. Fully supports the EFCA Statement of Faith and Constance Purpose and Strategy
- 4. High School education with preferred Education or Christian Ministry Degree
- 5. Children's programming experience
- 6. Strong communication skills
- 7. A passion for ministering to children
- 8. Ability to mobilize others in ministry
- 9. Ability to oversee volunteer ministry staff

Responsibilities (70%):

- 1. Recruits and tracks children's ministry volunteers for Sundays and Tuesdays
- 2. Assists in planning and carrying out the volunteer trainings
- 3. Communicates with all coordinators new recruits
- 4. Plans and carries out themes, props and visuals to enhance ministry
- 5. Develops a team to do the work of enhancing Bible messages, themes, visuals, props, costumes, etc.
- 6. Runs "The Store" (shops, stocks, inventories and staffs the store)
- 7. Plans and ensures Constance Initiatives and special emphasis
- 8. Ensures volunteer are appreciated
- 9. Oversees small group leaders/guides both Sundays and Tuesdays for grades 3-5
- 10. Plans activities for grades 3-5 both Sundays and T&T as well as 5th grade special events
- 11. Collaborates on special events for age group at key times of the year
- 12. Ensures Sunday & Tuesday's grades 3-5 has all its workers do ministry
- 13. Collaborates and helps to create and plans "Sticky Faith" events for parents

Administration (15%):

- 1. Posts photos and special events using ministry social media networks
- 2. Communicates special projects and events
- 3. Collaborates with ministry coordinators and associate
- 4. Oversees the management of props and other visual materials
- 5. Responsible to upholding of security practices among volunteers
- 6. Promotes Pre-teach for parents, weekly Bible verse memory, contests and teaching times

Workers/Training (15%):

- 1. Develops a ministry team to help carry out ministry, communicates with them regularly
- 2. Recruits, interviews, and trains potential new volunteers in the ministry
- 3. Delegates tasks to volunteers for small groups, leaders, painting, props etc.
- 4. Evaluates, empowers, and encourages all volunteers to improve in their area of service
